**“LOCAL SALMON RESTORATION”**

**Speakers:** *Sarah Spaeth, Executive Director of Jefferson Land Trust  
and founder of Chumsortium*

*Rebecca Benjamin, Executive Director at North Olympic Salmon Coalition*

Some members may remember our great salmon feast on the Kala Point beach and hearing about the salmon restoration project along Chimacum Creek. It was fun and exciting to hear about school children planting trees and everyone’s hope that we could recover a chum run. Well, we are very pleased to have an update on the chum run in Chimacum Creek and ongoing efforts to reestablish runs on Snow Creek in Discovery Bay. We will learn about Chumsortium—salmon restoration and habitat.

Sarah has been involved with conservation work for nearly twenty years. With degrees in biology and a masters degree in coastal zone management from the University of Washington, Sarah was hired in 1996 as Jefferson Land Trust’s first professional staff for the proactive Quimper Wildlife Corridor project. Since then she served as the Conservation Director for several years prior to becoming the Executive Director. She has conducted delicate and complex easement negotiations with the majority of our landowner partners, developed baseline reports, supervised preparation of management plans, prepared purchase and sale agreements, and written more than \$4 million worth of successful land acquisition funding proposals. Prior to working for Jefferson Land Trust, she worked as a consultant on marine resources issues and as a fisheries biologist in Alaska. She and her husband Tom George have three grown sons, and she spends her free time hiking, enjoying the great Northwest and growing food in her garden.

The talk is pretty basic and not into math very much, everyone is invited and it would be great to get PTYC folks there. I think there is to be a \$5 donation for PTSA for non-members. The models were built as visualization tools to explain some concepts like waterplane area and much will be appropriate for power boat owners. I have a fish tank I'm bringing to illustrate some concepts and a lot of "hands-on".

I have to tell you though, the Western Red Cedar was spectacular! It was fun building the models but the wood just jumped at me once I got some varnish on it. The wood was aged about 40-50 years on a deck so a lot of the color and figuring may have come from the wet/dry cycles. The double-ender had nice wood but the "Q" class boat with the overhangs and the 27' boat I designed used the best of the very limited supply.

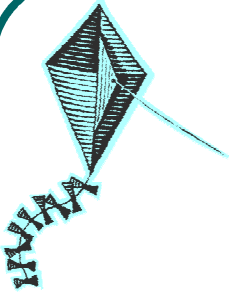
