Richard will update the topic of current fuel requirements and those coming down the pipeline in relation to recreational boating.

**PTYC announces a rare opportunity
for 35 Club members to tour a
submarine in Bangor this winter!!!**

Basic Requirements:

- Proof of U. S. citizenship—(valid US passport, enhanced Washington driver's license, NEXUS card, birth certificate).
- Physical ability to maneuver around on the submarine, including getting through hatches and climbing down (or up) three flights of a near-vertical ladder (about 30 feet).

This all-day-tour slated for Tuesday, February 7, 2012, may likely start at the Naval Undersea Warfare Museum at Keyport: followed by a tour of the training facilities in the morning; lunch at an on-base restaurant (people pay for their own lunch) and conclude with a detailed submarine tour.

A sign-up sheet for members meeting the basic requirements will be provided at the October General Meeting. A lottery might decide the prequalified members selected to participate in this extraordinary event. Many thanks to retired submariner and fellow PTYC member Bill Rothert for arranging this special tour.

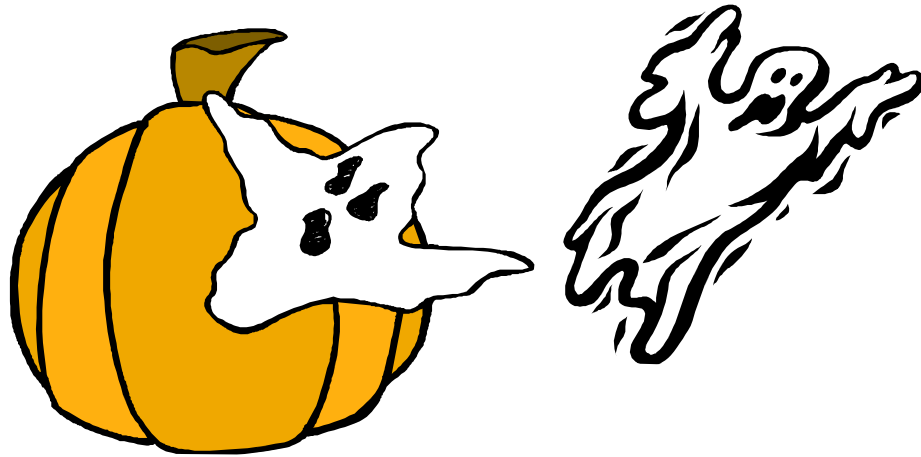
