

Information for participants in the 2017 T37 Regional Championship

Where are we?

- ✚ Port Ludlow is the first town (village) on the west side of the Hood Canal Bridge. It is about 35 minutes from Kingston and 45 minutes from Bainbridge. The Hood Canal Bridge on Hwy 104 has occasional closures of 15-45 minutes to allow boats to pass. Some closures of up to 90 minutes will be unannounced due to Homeland Security/Navy rules.
- ✚ Port Townsend is the largest town on the Quimper Peninsula, population about 8,500 with a tourist-oriented downtown. It is located about 20 miles (30 minutes) north of Port Ludlow. It can be reached from Whidbey Island by the Coupeville/PT ferry (30 minute passage, reservations suggested on weekends).
- ✚ Travel time. From the ferry terminals, allow 1.5 hrs from Edmonds, 1.75 hrs from Seattle. From Tacoma--1.5 hours, Olympia--2 hours, Vancouver B.C.~3 hours plus border crossing and ferry.

Racing Schedule:

- ✚ On Friday, April 21, we'll have a practice session from 2-4 pm in one or both of the marina ponds. You may weigh your boats at this time, followed by Happy Hour at the Port Ludlow Resort Inn (at your own expense).
- ✚ On Saturday, April 22, late registration and weigh from 9:00-9:30 am, Skippers Meeting is 9:30, First Race is at 10:00 (wind allowing). We'll have a mid-day lunch break and continue racing to about 3:30 pm. Awards to follow, hopefully we'll be done by 4:30 pm.

Racing Venue:

- ✚ We race at the Port Ludlow Resort and Marina (see map of area). There are two ponds next to the Port Ludlow Yacht Club, which will serve as our hospitality center for the Skippers Meeting, Lunch, and Awards. Pond usage will depend on wind conditions. Both are brackish water, relatively free of milfoil, and are >2 ft deep except along the margins.

Where to Stay:

- ✚ The closest place to stay is at the Port Ludlow Resort or Marina, which has rooms and slips available (reservations should be made at least 30 days in advance). For rooms, guests should book online (<http://www.portludlowresort.com>) or call to make a reservation (1-800-732-1239).
- ✚ Additional rooms are available at a variety of hotels, B&Bs, and guest houses in Port Townsend, or in Poulsbo to the east. An affordable yet clean PT motel we like is the Harborview, next to the Boat Haven Marina in PT. This is a 30-minute drive north of Port Ludlow.
- ✚ Marina slips at Port Ludlow are based on \$1.10/ft; 30 ft would be \$33/night, 40 ft would be \$44/night. Electric service is \$5 extra. For yacht club members they have 80 ft of reciprocal moorage that is available first come/first serve (2 boats). The marina phone is 1-800-308-7991.
- ✚ RV spots are available at the Port Ludlow RV Park. Rates are \$25/night plus tax.

Where to Eat:

- ✚ The Port Ludlow Resort has full-service dining facilities (the Fireplace Restaurant). Happy hour is daily from 4-6 pm. The marina has minimal food supplies, coffee, beer, wine, etc. There is an Italian restaurant (Cucina Pizza) and a seafood cafe (Snug Harbor) about a mile of the marina. Port Townsend, 30 minutes to the north, has at least a dozen nice restaurants that run the gamut from fine Continental cuisine, to seafood, Asian, pizza, Italian, anon. Plus the Port Townsend Brewery and the PourHouse. Ask questions if you are interested in dining in town.

What to Do:

- ✚ If you bring a partner that is looking for things to do, Port Ludlow has a golf course, hiking trails, and marine activities. Port Townsend has several movie houses, the PT Marine Science Center, the NW Maritime Center, Fort Worden (State Park), many fine galleries, and shopping galore. You can easily kill a day and a credit card in town.

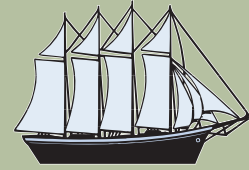
