Ditch Bag or 48 Hour Bag:

water tight dry bag/sack that floats
flairs - 8 - air/day flairs and smoke flairs or smoke bombs -these work best day or night
H2O bag
bailing devise - cut off plastic bottle works
strobe light
mirror
knife
manually charged flashlight and radio
black garbage bags for PFD.'s
dry clothes, extra socks
air pump
Gorilla Tape
hand held VHF
pliers with wire cutters
thermal blanket
H2O dry suits, insulated gloves and booties
stocking cap
International distress flag
Leatherman

Other Important Equipment that is available:

CO detector by CO Experts -\$200.00
Life raft - SOS Marine Austrailia - \$950.00
PLB - personal Location Beacon
EPIRB - Emergency Position Indicating Radio Beacon
GPS - personal
Block and Tackle to lift overboard passenger back on to boat
Swim ladder that can be accessed from the water
If you fall into the water DON'T BREATH
